Notice to Exhibitors

1. Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, or telephoned entries cannot be accepted. Entries without fees are not acceptable.
2. **PLEASE TYPEWRITE or NEATLY PRINT** all entries. Use black or blue ink as entries will be photocopied. DO NOT use pencil or colored ink to write entries.
3. **ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS** or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
4. **CHANGES**, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Telephone changes are unacceptable.
5. **OWNERS OR THEIR AGENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS** on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete. **FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES.**
6. **ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED** in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date and time, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, strikes, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
7. **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY.** The Treasurer will add a collection fee of \$25.00 plus bank fees to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors or agent may result in their being put on a cash-only basis.
8. **CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY & SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME** will be mailed after the closing date to the address on the Official AKC Entry Form and sent electronically if an email address is provided on the entry form. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show, the Show Secretary should be contacted.
9. **PLEASE NOTE:** Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show. (Dog Show Rules, Chapter 11, Section 6)
10. **DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW** only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately after unless required for further judging.
11. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.
12. **THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL USE CARE** and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, nor assume the responsibility in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show. The welfare of the exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. Please secure proper crates or means to confine dogs for the welfare of all concerned.
13. **UNENTERED DOGS:** Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under The American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts, except that dog engaged as a special attraction with AKC approval may also be present (e.g., a puppy ENTERED in the 4-6 Mo. Puppy Competition). These dogs shall be subject to all rules relating to health and veterinarians. Puppies under 4 months old are not allowed in show precincts.
14. An **AGENT** is a person 18 years or older, other than an owner or co-owner, designated by the owner or co-owner to be handler or, and responsible for, the dog at the show. Agents' names may be followed by the initials which represent their AKC-recognized professional group affiliation or certification. Persons seeking the services of such an agent should familiarize themselves with the requirements for professional group membership or certifications.
15. **OFA Numbers** will be included in the catalog if specified with entry form.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed or Variety competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record, or Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the day of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. Winners of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes may also compete in the Best of Breed Competition, provided that they are undefeated in any Regular Class at this show.

BEST PUPPY

Chosen from the winners of Puppy Dogs 6-9, Puppy Dogs 9-12, Puppy Bitches 6-9, and Puppy Bitches 9-12.

BEST BRED-BY EXHIBITOR

Chosen from the winners of Bred-By Dogs and Bred-By Bitches.

AWARDS OF MERIT

Offered at Thursday, Saturday and Sunday Shows. The Clubs will offer Awards of Merit each day to deserving Saints for recognition of their quality. It is entirely the judge's decision whether to give all or none of the available awards. Awards of Merit are selected from Saints in the Best of Breed Competition, other than the Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex winners. The number of Awards available is determined by the size of the entry present: 1 Award for 4-9 Specials, 2 Awards for 10 or more Specials.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog

Brood Bitch

STUD DOG CLASS, for Dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The Get is to be judged, not the Stud Dog. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and be shown in the ring with his Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS, for Bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The Produce is to be judged, not the Brood Bitch. Owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be the owner of the Produce. Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and be shown in the ring with her Produce. As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged First in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes. Note: Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes will be judged after Best of Breed.

Brace class, A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner.

Brace is offered on Friday, Saturday and Sunday only.
